- **Lot, Abram's nephew, was taken captive in battle.**
- **Abram gathered a small army of 318 trained men and rescued Lot and all the people and goods that were taken.**
- **Melchizedek was a priest of God Most High.**
- **When the evil king of Sodom offered to reward Abram, Abram said "No, thank you." He didn't want that evil king to say that he had made Abram rich.**



- **God took Abram outside and to look up because his offspring would be like the stars in the sky – too many to count.**
- **Genesis 15:6 says, “Abram believed the Lord, and the Lord credited it to him as righteousness.”**
- **Righteousness means perfection in God’s eyes. God saw Abram’s faith, the fact that Abram believed the Lord, and it was perfection in God’s eyes.**
