- God would not have destroyed Sodom is there were at least 10 righteous people who lived there.
- Abraham's 3 visitors who appeared as men were actually the Lord God and two angels.
- The angel told Lot and his family, "Run for your lives. Don't look back and don't stop."
- The two cities Sodom and Gomorrah were destroyed with burning sulfur.
- Lot's wife looked back even though the angel told her not to.



- Lot's wife became a pillar of salt because she disobeyed.
- Luke 17 tells us to remember
 Lot's wife and then warns us that
 anyone who tries to keep their life
 will lose it.
- Lot's wife was trying to keep her old sinful life in Sodom.
- If you have never called on the name of the Lord Jesus to save you, then you need to repent of your sins, believe in Jesus and receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior.
- Repent means to turn away from your sin.

TEACH ME The Bible Stories

- To believe in Jesus means to believe Jesus is the Savior of the world, to believe Jesus is God the Son who lived a perfect life and never sinned, and to be believe Jesus is the one and only Savior who died on the cross taking the punishment for your sin and then rose again on the 3rd day.
- To receive Jesus into your life as your Savior and Lord means that Jesus forgives you of all your sin and then Jesus becomes your Lord, the One in charge over you.
