1) How many years was Joseph in prison after Joseph told the cupbearer to tell Pharaoh about him?

ANSWER: 2 years

3) In Pharaoh's dream, how many fats cows came up out of the Nile River?

5) Then Pharaoh had a second dream about 7 heads of full and healthy heads of grains followed by how many thin and unhealthy heads of grain?

ANSWER: 7

 ANSWER: There would be 7 years of great famine to come after the 7 years of great harvest.
- 7) Joseph told Pharaoh that he should look for a discerning and wise man to be in charge of saving a fifth of the grain during the 7 years of harvest so there would be enough grain during the 7 years of famine. Who did Pharaoh decide was to be that discerning and wise man to be in charge?

ANSWER: Joseph

- 9) How many years was Joseph either a slave or in prison?

ANSWER: 13 years
