### **Judah's Great Blessing - Genesis 46 - 50**

- 1) How many Israelites were living in Egypt after Israel and his family moved there?  
ANSWER: 70
- 2) Where did Joseph promise to bury his father?  
ANSWER: In the land of Canaan where Isaac and Abraham were buried
- 3) Manasseh was Joseph's firstborn son and Ephraim was his second son but who did Israel give the blessing of the firstborn to?  
ANSWER: Ephraim
- 4) In Judah's blessing, we see signs pointing to Jesus as King, Shepherd, Lord and Savior. Israel said, "The scepter will not depart from Judah." Does this point to Jesus as King, Shepherd, Lord or Savior?  
ANSWER: King
- 5) In Judah's blessing, Israel said the staff will not depart from Judah's feet. Does this point to Jesus as King, Shepherd, Lord or Savior?  
ANSWER: Shepherd
- 6) In Judah's blessing, Israel says that the obedience of the people belongs to Him. Does this point to Jesus as King, Shepherd, Lord or Savior?  
ANSWER: Lord
- 7) In Judah's blessing, Israel said that He washes his clothes in wine and His robes in the blood of grapes. Does this point to Jesus as King, Shepherd, Lord or Savior?  
ANSWER: Savior
- 8) After Israel or Jacob died, what were Joseph's brothers afraid of?  
ANSWER: That Joseph was waiting for their father to die to get even with them
- 9) Instead of focusing on what his brothers did wrong, what did Joseph focus on?  
ANSWER: how God planned it for good. Joseph realized God was the One in charge
- 10) What did Joseph make his relatives promise him before he died?  
ANSWER: to carry his bones with them when they leave Egypt and return to the land of Canaan to take possession of the land
