ANSWER: locusts
- 3) The 9th plague was darkness. How many days was in completely dark and the sun didn't shine?
ANSWER: 3 days
- 4) Then Pharaoh said all the Israelites could go but what could not go?
ANSWER: their sheep and cows
- 5) Why wouldn't Moses and Aaron agree to that?
ANSWER: Because God commanded for their sheep and cows to go
- 6) The final plague was Plague of the firstborn. Moses warned Pharaoh that WHO would die in his home and every home in Egypt?
ANSWER: his firstborn son and every firstborn son in Egypt
- 7) God gave instructions to the Israelites to prepare for Passover. What kind of sheep- or goat where the Israelites to keep in their home like a pet for 4 days?
ANSWER: an unblemished, perfect one-year old sheep or goat.
- 8) On the 14th day, what was to be put on the doorframes of the Israelite homes?
ANSWER: blood from that animal

ANSWER: gods of Egypt
- 10) The Lord said that when He sees the blood on the doorframes, He will do what?
ANSWER: pass over so that no one will die in that home
