Lesson 3 Visuals

- Sin is disobeying God's commands.
- The punishment for sin is Death.
- Romans 6:23 "The wages of sin is death."
- The devil took the form of a serpent in Genesis chapter 3.
- The serpent's first 4 words to Eve were: "Did God really say?"
- If we have questions about God or about God's commands, we should go to the Bible for our answers.



- The serpent lied when he said,
 "No, you will not die."
- God's commands are for our good.
- If we trust God and trust that all of God's commands are for our good, we will want to obey God.
- God told Adam, "The day you eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you will certainly die."
- Immediately after Adam and Eve sinned, they died spiritually.
- Adam and Eve sewed fig leaves together to cover themselves.



- Adam and Eve hid from God because of their shame.
- Lord means the one in charge.
- Jesus is the only person who has never sinned.

Key Verses:
