- 3) How did God lead the Israelites by day? ANSWER: pillar of cloud by day
- 4) How did God lead them at night? ANSWER: pillar of fire by night.
- 5) God did not lead the Israelites on the fastest way because they weren't ready to go face the Philistines in battle. Instead, He led them to what body of water?

  ANSWER: the Red Sea
- 6) The Israelites were between the Red Sea and a tall wall of mountains, when they saw what coming?
  - ANSWER: Pharaoh and his entire army
- 7) The Israelites were upset with Moses because they believed he brought them there to die. Then Moses told them that Who would fight for them?

  ANSWER: The Lord. He said, "The Lord will fight for you, you only need to be still."
- 8) What created a wall between the Egyptians and the Israelites? ANSWER: that pillar of cloud
- 9) The Lord told Moses to stretch out his staff over the Red Sea. What happened after he did that?
  - ANSWER: the waters were divided allowing the Israelites to cross on dry ground
- 10) What happened to Pharaoh and the whole Egyptian army?

  ANSWER: They were killed when the waters of the Red Sea came crashing down on them.
