

Crossing the Red Sea: Lesson 30 Visuals

- When Pharaoh found his firstborn son dead and he learned that all the Egyptian's lost their firstborn sons, Pharaoh told Moses and Aaron to go.
- The Egyptians encouraged the Israelites to leave quickly because the Egyptians were afraid they were all going to die.
- The Israelites were poor slaves who didn't own many valuables. Yet they were able to leave Egypt rich with many possessions.



- The Israelites asked them for silver, gold and clothing and the Egyptians just gave it to them. The Lord gave them favor.
- 500 years earlier God revealed to Abraham (Abram) that his descendants would be slaves for 400 years, God would judge the nation that held them and the people would leave rich with great possessions.
- Moses carried Joseph's bones out of Egypt.



- 600,000 Israelites men plus women and children began their journey out of Egypt.
- God led the Israelites by day with a pillar of cloud.
- God led them at night with a pillar of fire.
- God did not lead the Israelites on the fastest way because they weren't ready to go face the Philistines in battle. Instead He led them to the Red Sea.



- The Israelites were between the Red Sea and a wall of tall mountains and then they saw Pharaoh and his entire army coming.
- The Israelites were upset with Moses because they believed he brought them there to die. Moses told them, "The Lord will fight for you, you need only to be still."
- The pillar of cloud created a wall of protection between the Egyptians and the Israelites.
- The Lord told Moses to stretch out his staff over the Red Sea.



- Then the waters were divided allowing the Israelites to cross the Red Sea on dry ground.
- The Lord lifted that pillar of cloud and then the Egyptians began chasing after the Israelites.
- The Egyptian's chariot wheels got stuck and they had a difficult time getting through.
- Pharaoh and the whole Egyptian army were killed when the waters of the Red Sea came crashing down on them.
