



Lesson 31 Quiz & Answers: Bread from Heaven: Exodus 15 - 17

- 1) The Israelites crossed through the Red Sea and then went three days without water. When they came to Marah, they found water. But what was wrong with the water in Marah?
ANSWER: the water there was bitter
- 2) The Lord was testing them there to see if they would trust the Lord? What did they do that showed they didn't trust the Lord to take care of them?
ANSWER: They grumbled.
- 3) God told Moses what to do so that the water would be drinkable. What did Moses do?
ANSWER: He threw the tree God showed him into the water.
- 4) God provided meat for the Israelites to eat. What bird flew in each evening and covered the camp?
ANSWER: Quail
- 5) God provided bread from heaven each morning. What did the Israelites call the fine flakes that they found on the desert surface?_
ANSWER: manna
- 6) When there was no water at Rephidim, the people were so angry that they were ready to throw stones at Moses to kill him. The Lord told Moses what to do. What did Moses do?
ANSWER: He hit the rock at Horeb and water came out of the rock, providing drinking water for all the Israelites.
- 7) Moses sent out Joshua and a small army to fight the Amalekites. Joshua and his army were in the valley. Where were Moses, Aaron and Hur?
ANSWER: Up on the hill above them
- 8) The Israelites were winning as long as Moses did what?
ANSWER: lifted his staff above his head
- 9) Where was Moses pointing that staff that showed the Israelites were trusting in the Lord to give them victory?
ANSWER: towards God's throne in heaven.
- 10) What did Aaron and Hur do when Moses arms got tired?
ANSWER: They held his arms up

Bonus: According to Deuteronomy 8:15-16, why did God allow the Israelites to be tested with difficulties in the desert wilderness?

ANSWER: So that they might be humble and so that in the end it might go well for them.
