

Broken Tablets: Exodus 32 - 33
<u>Lesson 36 Visuals</u>

- Moses carried down God's two stone tablets engraved with the Ten commandments.
- When Moses saw the golden calf and the people dancing around it, he threw the tablets out of his hand.
- Those two stone tablets shattered into many broken pieces.



- The shattered stone tablets symbolized the fact that the Israelites had broken God's 10 Commandments and God's covenant agreement.
- Moses said, "Whoever is for the Lord, come to Me." Only the Levites came to Moses.
- The Levites were from the tribe of Levi. Moses and Aaron were also Levites.
- God told the Levites to run back and forth through the camp with a sword strapped to their sides.



- 3,000 men were struck by a sword and died that day.
- God also sent a deadly plague on the people who worshipped the golden calf.
- Moses asked the Lord to forgive the Israelites. The Lord responded saying, "Whoever has sinned against Me, I will erase from My book."
- The only people allowed into heaven are those whose names are written in God's book of life.



- God told Moses to lead the people to the land of Canaan; but He said His presence what would not go with them because they were too sinful.
- Moses said he did not want to leave without the Lord's presence.
- God responded saying that because Moses found favor with God, God's presence would go with them.
- The glory of God is the demonstration of God's presence.
- Moses asked the Lord, "Please, let me see Your glory."



- The Lord said to Moses, "I will make My goodness pass before you. But you cannot look at My face for humans cannot see Me and live."
- God is spirit so He does not have a physical body. But God's face means God's presence.
- Moses (or any human) cannot look directly at God's presence and live.
- God told Moses, "Humans cannot see Me and live." Jesus made it possible for humans look directly at God's presence.



 Jesus said, "Anyone who has seen Me has seen God the Father."
