- 1) God told Moses to count the Israelites at the beginning and end of Numbers. What do we call it when a large group of people are counted?
ANSWER: census
- 2) How many Israelites men 20 years and older were counted in that censuses? More than how many?
ANSWER: 600,000
- 3) What tribe was given the special honor of being able to transport and take care of the Tabernacle and its furnishings?
ANSWER: the Levites
- 4) The Kohathites, a Levite family, had a very important yet dangerous responsibility of moving the Ark of the Covenant. They were to wrap it in curtains and carry it with what?
ANSWER: with poles
- 5) What would happen if the Kohathites touched the Ark of the Covenant?
ANSWER: they would die
- 6) How did the Israelites know it was time to start traveling again?
ANSWER: the cloud lifted up
- 7) When the Israelites complained about how hard life was in the desert wilderness, what did the Lord send to blaze among them and burn the outskirts of the camp?
ANSWER: fire from the Lord
- 8) The Lord had taken such a good care of the Israelite. They should have been thankful and trusted that He would continue to take care of them. What did they do that is the opposite of being thankful and trusting the Lord?
ANSWER: complain
- 9) Moses questioned how the Lord could possibly provide meat for the Israelites to eat for a month. What did the Lord ask Moses, "Is the Lord's arm _____?"
ANSWER: weak
(Of course, not. He can do anything!!)
- 10) The Israelites complained about not having meat to eat. The Lord miraculously provided quail but what happened when the people ate that meat?
ANSWER: A plague struck. That meat made them sick.
