Forty Days as Spies - Numbers 13-14

- How long did the 12 spies spend in the land of Canaan?
 ANSWER: 40 days
- 2) What reason did the ten spies give for why they could NOT go in? ANSWER: The people in the land of Canaan were too strong.
- 3) The Israelites believed their wives and children would be killed if they went into Canaan. They said it would be better for them to go where? ANSWER: back to Egypt
- 4) Even though Joshua and Caleb only told the Israelites the truth, what did the Israelites want to do to them?
 - ANSWER: Stone them to death
- 5) What was the consequence for not trusting the LORD to give them the land of Canaan?
 - ANSWER: They would have to wonder in the desert wilderness for forty years.
- 6) Who did God say would die in the desert wilderness and would never enter the land of Canaan?
 - ANSWER: every man 20 years and older
- 7) What were the names of the two spies who had faith that God give them the Promised Land of Canaan?
 - ANSWER: Joshua and Caleb
- 8) Is it faith or presumption to believe God will bless our disobedience? ANSWER: presumption
- 9) What group of people had presumption in the story? ANSWER: Those who went to take the land of Canaan after God said not to go.
- 10) Faith is focused on doing things whose way? ANSWER: God's way
