3)	Moses prayed and called out to the Lord to stop the plague. What did God tell
	Moses to make?
	ANSWER: an image of a snake and mount it to a pole (a bronze snake)
4)	God commanded the people who were bitten by the snakes to look at the image of
	the snake. What happened to the people who looked at the image of the snake?
	ANSWER: They lived.
5)	John 3:14 and 15 tells us that just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness,
	so Jesus must be lifted up that everyone who believes may have what?
	ANSWER: Eternal life in Jesus (life or will live)
6)	Moses and the Israelites defeated the Amorite armies and took possession of their
	land. Why did this make the Moabites and King Balak afraid of the Israelites?
	ANSWER: They were afraid the same would happen to them.
7)	At first, the Lord told Balaam "Don't go because the Israelites are already blessed
	by God." But when King Balak's messengers went back with an even greater
	reward, the Lord said go but be careful to only what the tells
	him.

	ANSWER: the mouth of the donkey
10)	The Lord then opened Balaam's eyes and he saw the Angel of the Lord. The Angel
	of the Lord said to go but be careful to onlywhat the tells him.
