ANSWER: They stole their food and valuables. They oppressed and persecuted them. (at least one of those things for a correct answer)
- 4) What did the Israelites do to get the Lord's help?
ANSWER: They cried out to the Lord. (and/or) They prayed for help.
- 5) Who did the Lord raise up as the first judge over Israel who delivered the Israelites?
ANSWER: Othniel
- 6) After Othniel died, the Israelites turned away from the Lord and worshipped idols and false gods again. Because of that, the Lord gave the King of Moab power of what nation?
ANSWER: Israel
- 7) After 18 years of suffering under King Eglon of Moab, the Israelites cried out to the Lord. Who did the Lord raise up to save Israel from King Eglon?
ANSWER: Ehud
- 8) After Ehud killed the cruel King Eglon, Ehud left and locked the door behind him. What did his servants think King Eglon was doing?
ANSWER: They thought he was going to the bathroom.
- 9) Othniel was the first judge over Israel. Ehud was the second judge. Who was the third judge over Israel?
ANSWER: Shamgar
- 10) What did the Israelites do after each Israelite judge died?
ANSWER: returned to evil ways even worse than their parents
