  - ANSWER: Gathering to war against the Philistines
- 3) What did the Lord God do that threw the Philistines into a panic and made them run away?
  - ANSWER: The Lord made it thunder very loudly
- 4) The Israelites did not want either of Samuel's sons to ever be the chief judge. So what did they demand Samuel to appoint? ANSWER: a king over Israel
- 5) God said that they weren't rejecting Samuel. Rather, who were they rejecting? ANSWER: They were rejecting God as their king.
- 6) Saul was ready to give up the search for their donkeys, but the servant recommended they go see a man of God. Who was that man of God? ANSWER: Samuel
- 7) How did Samuel anoint Saul as king? What did Samuel pour out on Saul's head? ANSWER: a flask of oil

- 9) Where was Saul when Samuel called for him to declare him king? ANSWER: hiding among the baggage
- 10) Who did Saul give the credit for giving them victory over the Ammonites? ANSWER: the Lord God
