



## **Promises Kept & Mephibosheth:**

**2 Samuel 6-10, 1 Chronicles 17**

### **Lesson 67 Visuals**

- **Michal despised David in her heart when she saw David dancing and celebrating as the Ark of the covenant entered Jerusalem.**
- **Michal thought King David embarrassed himself by taking off his kingly robe in front of the servant girls. David said, “I will celebrate before the LORD and I will become even more undignified that this.”**
- **David told Nathan the prophet that he wanted to build a house for the LORD God.**
- **The LORD said David was not the one to build a house for the LORD.**
- **The LORD said He would build a house for David. Then the LORD said that one of David’s sons would be a house or a temple for the LORD.**



- **The LORD said He would establish the throne of this future king and He would reign forever!**
- **Jesus is the only king that reigns forever.**
- **David did not feel he was worthy to have the LORD God send the Savior of the world through his family line.**
- **God's message to David was not just for David. It was for all mankind.**
- **None of us are worthy to receive Jesus's salvation.**
- **We don't receive salvation because we are worthy but simply because God is gracious and merciful and because we respond to Jesus's invitation.**
- **David asked, "Is there anyone remaining from the family of Saul that I can show kindness to for Jonathan's sake?"**
- **Jonathan was Mephibosheth's father.**



- **When Mephibosheth was five years, his nurse fell while carrying him. He was dropped; and his feet were then permanently injured.**
- **David said Mephibosheth would eat all his meals from then on at King David's table.**
- **King David treated Mephibosheth like one of the king's sons.**
- **If we have responded to the invitation of Jesus, you and I are like Mephibosheth. We were permanently injured by our sin. Our sin separated us from a relationship with God and left us without hope. But God showed kindness to us and invited us into a loving relationship with him.**
