

Elijah's Whirlwind Trip to Heaven:

2 Kings 2-4

Lesson 78 Visuals

- Because Elijah did exactly what the LORD wanted to do, the LORD told Elijah that Elijah would go directly to heaven without dying first.
- The LORD sent Elijah to three different places: the city of Bethel, the city of Jericho and then to the Jordan River.
- The fifty prophets saw Elijah hit the Jordan River with his rolled-up robe.
- When Elijah hit the Jordan River with his rolled-up robe, the water of the Jordan River divided.
- Elijah asked Elisha what he could do for Elisha before he goes. Elisha asked for a double portion of Elijah's spirit.



- Elisha was asking for double the amount of God's power working through him to do miracles.
- For Elisha to have that double portion,
 Elisha had to see Elijah when he was taken up to heaven.
- As Elijah and Elisha were walking and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire appeared.
- The chariot of fire separated the two of them; and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.
- When Elisha rolled up Elijah's robe and hit the Jordan River with it, the water divided just as it had done for Elijah.
- Those prophets spent three days looking for Elijah.
- They didn't find him because Elijah was already in heaven.



- Elisha threw salt into the spring and then the Lord healed the bad water.
- The kings of Israel and Judah ran out of water in the desert as they were on their way to fight the Moabites.
- Elisha told them to do dig ditches throughout the valley there.
- The Lord promised to fill those ditches with water even though it wasn't going to rain.
- When the Moabites looked across the valley, they thought the water in the ditches was blood.
- A widow owed a debt she could not pay;
 and creditors were about to take her two sons
 away and make them into slaves.
- The only thing the widow had was a little oil.
- Elisha told the widow to get empty jars from all her neighbors.



- As she poured that little bit of oil into jar after jar, the oil multiplied, and she was able to fill every jar she had.
- After the widow sold those jars of oil, she was able to pay off her creditors and live off the rest.
