Boy's Life Returned & Naaman's Leprosy: 2 Kings 4-5

- 1) The Shunammite woman and her husband prepared a room for Elisha to stay in. Elisha then wanted to do something nice for her. What did Elisha's servant Gehazi say she needed?
ANSWER: a son
- 2) The son of the Shunammite woman complained to his father that his head was hurting him terribly. Later that day, what happened to the boy as he laid in his mother's arms?
ANSWER: He died.
- 3) Where did the Shunammite woman lay her dead son's body?
ANSWER: on Elisha's bed
- 4) The first time Elisha laid across the boy, the boy's body grew warm. What happened when Elisha stretched himself over the boy the second time?
ANSWER: He came back to life. (He sneezed seven times and opened his eyes.)
- 5) Naaman was the commander of Aram's army. What disease did Naaman develop?
ANSWER: leprosy
- 6) Who told Naaman's wife about the miracle-working prophet Elisha?
ANSWER: the Israelite slave girl
- 7) Elisha sent a message to Naaman. What river was Naaman told to go to?
ANSWER: the Jordan River
- 8) How many times was Naaman told to wash in the Jordan River before he would be healed?
ANSWER: seven times
- 9) What happened to Naaman's leprosy after that seventh time of dipping in the Jordan River?
ANSWER: It was gone. Naaman was healed.
- 10) Elisha did not receive Naaman's reward. But then Gehazi lied to Naaman to get some of that reward. What was the consequence of Gehazi's sin?
ANSWER: Gehazi developed leprosy.
