

## Jehu's Zeal & Joash's Fall: 2 Kings 8-12, 2 Chronicles 23-24 Lesson 81 Visuals

- The northern kingdom of Israel only had evil kings. They never had a good king who loved and obeyed God.
- The southern kingdom of Judah had a few good kings who were faithful to God. But the majority of their kings were evil too.
- Ahab was one of the worst kings in the northern kingdom of Israel.
- Jezebel was King Ahab's evil wife who led him to many of his bad choices.
- King Ahaziah of Judah was evil, and he partnered with the evil king of Israel.
- The prophet Elisha ordered Jehu to be anointed as king.
- Elisha instructed Jehu to kill Ahab's family.



- When Jezebel heard that Jehu was nearing, she painted her eyes with makeup, fixed her hair, and looked down from her window.
- Jehu yelled out, "Whoever is on my side, throw Jezebel down." Then several of Queen Jezebel's servants pushed Jezebel out her window.
- Dogs ate Jezebel's dead body.
- The prophet Elijah said years earlier that Jezebel would be eaten by dogs as a consequence of her evil ways.
- Ahab had seventy sons. In Jehu's zeal, he ordered all of them to be killed.
- Jehu had zeal for the LORD.
- Jehu struck down all who remained from the family of Ahab.
- Jehu also went after those who worshipped the false god Baal.



- Jehu tricked people into thinking he served Baal. Once all the servants of Baal were in Baal's temple, Jehu ordered everyone inside of that temple to be killed with a sword.
- Jehu successfully get rid of Baal worship in Israel.
- Athaliah began killing all the royal heirs.
   Ahaziah's sister saw what was happening so she him baby Joash, the son of dead King Ahaziah.
- Joash and his nurse hid in the temple for six years while Queen Athaliah ruled Judah.
- Priest Jehoiada ordered military commanders to protect Joash while Joash was crowned king.
- After Queen Athaliah yelled, "Treason! Treason!", the military commanders carried her out of the temple and put her to death.



- Under the leadership of priest Jehoiada, the people of Judah got rid of Baal worship in Judah.
- Joash was only seven years old when he began his reign as king.
- King Joash ordered for money to be collected and used to repair the temple.
- A chest was put outside at the gate of LORD's temple to collect money to repair the temple.
- The people gave glady to repair the temple. They did not have a bad attitude about giving money.
- When the chest was full, they took money out of the chest to pay builders and to purchase building supplies.
- King Joash turned to idol worship after the death of Jehoiada the priest.



- The Spirit of God came on Zechariah, and he declared God's message to the people of Judah. They did not receive God's message. Instead, they stoned Zechariah to death.
- God allowed a small army from Aram to invade Judah and kill its leaders as a consequence of Judah's evil ways.
- Joash's own officials murdered him.
- God blesses obedience and punishes disobedience.
- There are always bad consequences for disobeying God.
- Philippians 4:13 says, "I can do all things through Christ Jesus who gives me strength."
